INT. BONNIE'S CAR- DAY

BONNIE is driving in her car during rush hour traffic.

BONNIE

Get out the way! Where did you even
learn how to drive?!

[FX:HORN HONKING]

Suddenly, the car starts to smoke and hiss. Bonnie turns the
wheel and pulls the car to the side of the road.

BONNIE

No no no. Not today. You can't be
doing this to me old girl.

Bonnie pulls out her phone.

BONNIE

Oh god, let me call the insurance
company for a tow truck.

A split screen appears as a PHONE REP answers Bonnie's call.

PHONE REP

Hi, thank you for calling roadside
assistance, how can we help you?

BONNIE

Hi, yeah. Can you send out a tow
truck to me. My car is going
haywire.

PHONE REP

Sure ma'am, where are you?

BONNIE

I don't know, I'm on the highway on
the side of the road! Can't you see
my phone or something?! Isn't this
the 21st century?

PHONE REP

Not to worry ma'am, I can use your
phone's location. I see you now, we
can have a truck out to you in the
next four hours.

The split screen goes away and it goes back to just Bonnie

FADE IN:

INT. MECHANIC SHOP- NIGHT

BONNIE

yet. Your car just got here. I'll

BONNIE
Well, look at it. I need to get
outta here and back home.

MECHANIC
Oh, this car isn't going anywhere
tonight.

BONNIE
Well how am I supposed to get home?

MECHANIC
I don't know, call an Uber I guess.

INT. THE BURGUNDY BISTRO- DAY

TAMMY, MARJORIE, JILL, and WENDY sit at their usual booth as
Bonnie walks into the restaurant.

TAMMY
Whoah girlie, where the heck have
you been? You look like hell.

JILL
Yeah, we've been sitting here
waiting for you for what feels like
forever.

MARJORIE
Oh ladies, give her a break she
must be going through it enough,
just look at here

Wendy nods her head as she eats her meal.

BONNIE
Dear God, do I really look that
bad? But Thank you Marjorie. If you
must know, my car broke down on me
yesterday and I have been taking
Ubers everywhere.

Jill puts her hand to her chest and Tammy has a shocked look
on her face.

JILL
Oh my word, I can't believe you are
taking ubers around. The seems so
diry, so, poor.

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
